

# HK-DB Monthly International Open (FIDE Rated) Regulations

#### About us

HKMS is a new brand for hosting chess tournaments co-founded by Kidult Chess Academy. We believe that participating in monthly FIDE rated Standard tournaments is a necessity in the path of Chess improvement. Our aim is to organize standard tournaments monthly in a comfortable yet competitive environment with minimal effort on traveling. We hope this platform will bring you the greatest opportunity to practice and fulfill your potential on becoming a Grandmaster!

### Why Monthly FIDE rated Standard Tournament?

- Every chess player wants to know where he stands among the world and only
   FIDE rating can fulfill this purpose, FIDE ID is the key to connect with the world.
- FIDE rating is updated monthly whenever you play a game to reflect the
  player's strength accordingly, this will give chess players a great motivation for
  practice.
- We believe calculation skill is crucial for chess improvement and the standard time control is the only format that allows players to practice their calculation skill during the game.
- Standard tournaments around Asia are not hosted regularly compared to Europe so we hope to fill this gap.



#### **Tournament Regulations**

- 1. This is an individual tournament, open to all players with FIDE ID number and rating <2000.
- 2. FIDE (International Chess Federation) Law of Chess, rules and regulations shall apply. Results will be sent for FIDE rating calculations.
- 3. Tournament will be played using a 9-round Swiss System. For the pairings, a Swiss Manager program will be used.
- 4. The matches shall be conducted according to the schedule, any changes will be made known to the respective players before the start of the tournament.
- 5. Each player is accorded with a time control of 60 minutes. There is a 30-second increment per move, starting from move one.
- 6. Five minutes before the games start, the Chief Arbiter shall make the announcement accordingly. If any player is not present within 30 minutes after the game is started, he shall lose by default.
- 7. Officials and players should be smartly attired at all times while in the playing hall.
- 8. Players may elect to take a bye for one round (except the final round), with a half point awarded. The official request must be completed in writing before the end of the previous round.
- 9. Any player unable to attend any round must inform the Arbiters' desk in writing before the end of the previous round. Failure to do so may result in not being paired for subsequent rounds.
- 10. We reserve the right to refuse registration from a player that has been repeatedly complained during our events.
- 11. There will be photos or video taken by our official photographers during the event, by registering you allow us to share the media which could include you on social platforms.
- 12. In the event of dispute, the Chief Arbiter's decision is final.

#### **Prizes**

- 1st prize: \$4000 HKD + Trophy;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> prize: \$1500 HKD + Trophy;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> prize: \$1000 HKD + Trophy;
- 1st prize under 1700: \$1000 HKD + Trophy
- 2<sup>nd</sup> prize under 1700: \$600 HKD + Trophy
- 3<sup>rd</sup> prize under 1700:\$400 HKD + Trophy

All tournament fees must be paid before the start of the first round. Early Bird registration is available until Nov 30, 2024 with a \$200 discount. Tournament fees are refundable with a \$200 admin fee on or before Nov 30.2024.

- 1. The tournament conference will provide paper and pens for recording chess records. All items other than drinks will not be accepted in the tournament venue.
- 2. The arbiters are independent of the organizer. All decisions are made by the organizer and have no right to intervene. If there are any complaints about the game and the players should submit them to the arbiters during the game, they will not be accepted after the game is over and the players leave the field.
- 3. After the start of the competition, players are prohibited from using any electronic products, and must undergo metal detection every time they leave and enter the venue. If they are found to be using electronic products in violation of regulations, or carrying electronic products in and out of the venue, they will be disqualified.
- 4. If you need to withdraw from the competition and get a refund, the entry fee must be applied to us before November 30, 2024, and an administrative fee of 200 yuan will be deducted. There will be no refunds starting from December 1, 2024.
